Perpich Arts High School is looking for motivated, self-disciplined students entering 11th or 12th grade in the 2019-2020 school year, students who are enthusiastic about the arts and demonstrate a strong commitment to serious study in academics. Admissions Committee members are trained to identify *potential* for learning in a specific art discipline, as well as *demonstrated* accomplishments. Perpich has accepted students with years of experience, and others with no formal training in their discipline. For students showing natural ability, we hope to cultivate this in our unique school setting.

This application, along with any supporting documentation included, is your opportunity to share information you would like considered by the Admissions Committee. All documentation submitted will be confidential. The Admissions Committee reserves the right to request additional documentation to support your candidacy for admission.

After reviewing your application materials, eligible applicants will be contacted with the day and time of their admission review, as well as information on what to prepare.

- Geometry is not offered at Perpich. Students are encouraged to complete geometry prior to applying.
- Incoming seniors must present with a minimum 2.0 GPA.

No payment is required at the time of application. After an offer of admission is extended by Perpich and accepted by the student/family, admitted students will be invoiced a \$100 acceptance fee. This fee covers costs related to the admission process and is non-refundable. When Perpich receives payment and the required acceptance paperwork, the student's enrollment will be complete.
