Liz Lerman invented the Critical Response Protocol (CRP), a specific protocol that we have used at Perpich in many iterations. It is based in a few principles:

- Acknowledging the knowledge of the whole group (therefore dismantling teacher as central - very student-centered and culturally responsive)
- Practice in giving/receiving feedback
- Coaching based on the idea that everyone is interested in the other's success - helping them do their best work

Liz is currently at Arizona State University where she is exploring innovative ways to use the CRP in an online setting.
