Plan: Initiate discussions with curriculum director and/or administration to lay out district transition timelines for full implementation during the 2021-22 school year. Administrators and Curriculum Directors

Actions for Development Phase* January 2019-September 2019

Plan: Develop an action plan for the transition to full implementation of the 2018 arts education standards.

- Convene a team that includes arts educators, administrators, curriculum directors, and other stakeholders.
- Develop a plan to revise curriculum and provide curriculum development supports including timelines, budgets, professional learning system, and evaluation.
- Determine if a phase-in process is desired and feasible, and if so, plan for it.
- Investigate whether enough time is being allotted to provide students the skills and knowledge to meet the grade-level benchmarks, and create a plan to address any course, scheduling or staffing needs.
- Develop a communication plan for all stakeholders.

Professional Development (PD):

Develop a shared understanding of 2018 arts standards with teachers and the shifts required to implement.

Communicate: Communicate the transition process with internal and external stakeholders.

Actions for Transition, Phase 1* September 2019-June 2020

Professional Development (PD): Plan and provide district-specific arts educator professional learning and support for the 2018 standards and benchmarks.

Resources:

- Assure appropriate resources are available for professional development, curriculum revision and phase-in support.
- Implement plan to address any course, schedule or staffing needs related to providing students the skills and knowledge to meet the required grade-level benchmarks.

Curriculum: Initiate development of standards-based curriculum and assessments.

Roll-Out: Initiate a phase-in stage if desired and feasible.

Communicate: Communicate the transition process with internal and external stakeholders.

Actions for Transition, Phase 2* July 2020-June 2021

Professional Development (PD): Provide district-specific arts educator professional learning and support for the 2018 standards and benchmarks.

Resources:

- Continue to assure appropriate resources are available for professional development, curriculum revision and phase-in support.
- Implement plan to address any course, schedule or staffing needs related to providing students the skills and knowledge to meet the required grade-level benchmarks.

Curriculum: Finalize arts education curriculum based on the 2018 standards and grade-level benchmarks. Complete any district adoption requirements.

Roll-Out: Initiate a phase-in stage if desired and feasible.

Communicate: Communicate updates regarding the transition process with internal and external stakeholders.

Full Implementation* 2021-22 School Year

Roll-Out: Ensure full implementation of the adopted 2018 standards and grade-level benchmarks.

Professional Development (PD):

Continue professional learning and support for arts educators, grounded in a process of continuous improvement.

Curriculum: Assess curriculum and sustain curriculum improvement efforts over time.

Communicate: Share information about the revised arts education program with students, parents, educators, and community through school district communication vehicles.

Communicate: Disseminate transition announcements online as well as through districts and other stakeholders. Gather feedback from field on priorities for support. Post final 2018 standards on MDE webpage.	 Professional Development (PD): Provide web-based and regional professional learning opportunities to support arts education teachers.
